- Fretboard: 0 (D), 0 (G), 0 (B), 0 (F).

Measure 7 (right system):

- Notes: G7 (quarter), A7 (quarter), B7 (quarter), C8 (quarter).
- Fretboard: 0 (D), 0 (G), 0 (B), 0 (F).

Measure 8 (right system):

- Notes: D8 (quarter), E8 (quarter), F8 (quarter), G8 (quarter).
- Fretboard: 0 (D), 0 (G), 0 (B), 0 (F).
